Dart stated that the CI of Algoma \$50,000.00 CD is up for renewal. After much discussion, Peterman motioned to renew the CD for a six-month period; second by Schmitz. Motion carried.

**Old Business:**

1. **Mural Update:** Meverden informed Jim/Havegard about our discussion with Erin relating to his silo project. It was suggested that a better option might be a wrapping art mural.

There are a couple new murals in downtown Algoma: one on the Vandenaek Plumbing alley wall, the other on Tina Marie's building.

2. **Calendar Update:** Peterman turned in \$160.00 and reported that he has roughly 1 ½ boxes of calendars in his garage. Hepp has approximately ½ box remaining. Dart one box.
3. **WWWF Update:** Dart suggested that rather than having a band play in between grape stomps, why not have the DJ play appropriate music. This would be a substantial savings.
